

# Announcement of the Haflinger World Show from 2. to 6. June 2010 in the Haflinger World Centre Ebbs

**1. ORGANIZER:** Haflinger Breeders' Association Tyrol, Schlossallee 31, A-6341 Ebbs

**2. AUTHORIZATION:** Haflinger World Show under the patronage of the World Haflinger Federation, authorised by the general meeting on 17 July 2006 in Great Malvern – GB.

**3. TYPE OF EVENT :** Breed show only for purebred Haflinger horses in collections according to the regulations of the World Haflinger Federation. However there will be individual judging of horses exhibited in the collections.

**4. ANNOUNCEMENT :** The announcement takes place through the official organ of the Haflinger Breeders' Association Tyrol and the magazine "Haflinger Pferde" worldwide directly to all member organizations of the World Haflinger Federation by circular letter and on the internet at [www.haflingerworldshow.com](http://www.haflingerworldshow.com).

**5. THE FOLLOWING COLLECTIONS MAY BE EXHIBITED:**

## **5.1 STALLION COLLECTIONS**

- 5.1.1 Stallions with offspring in consecutive generations of at least three generations
- 5.1.2 Offspring collections of stallions – ten years and older (at least ten offspring)
- 5.1.3 Offspring collections of stallions up to the age of nine (at least eight offspring)
- 5.1.4 Offspring collections of stallions that are no longer used for stud and therefore not exhibited (at least ten offspring)

## **5.2 MARE COLLECTIONS**

- 5.2.1 Mares with offspring in consecutive generations (at least three generations)
- 5.2.2 Offspring collections of mares – fourteen years and older (at least three offspring)
- 5.2.3 Offspring collections of mares up to fourteen years old (at least two offspring)

**6. PREVIEW:** Horse that are classified in Tyrolean collections and are registered will be previewed by the Tyrolean Association management.

**7. REGISTRATION:** Horse must be registered by the latest January 2010 by sending copies of proof of offspring or horse passes with proof of at least six generations and an association certificate of being purebred (0% foreign blood according to the regulations of the World Haflinger Federation), coverings or foaling registration for mares with foals including the father of the foal. The foal registrations for the catalogue can be sent later but by the latest 1. May. Collections from associations and also breeders can be registered directly.

**8. NUMBER OF HORSE TO BE EXHIBITED:** There is no limit to the number of horses that can be exhibited per exhibiting nation or breeders' association but however a total upper limit of exhibited horses for both stallions and mares. The limitation will take place according to the time of receipt of registrations. Scheduled are a maximum of 100 stallions, 250 mother mares, 100 mares and 250 fillies, so that the upper limit will be 700 exhibited horses (not including foals).

**9. JUDGING OF THE HORSES:** The judging of the horses will be done by international judges that are on the current list of the World Haflinger Federation. It is possible that national judges of the Tyrolean association may be added.

**10. ACCOMMODATION OF THE HORSES:** The accommodation for mares without foals is exclusively in fenced boxes in the tent. For mother mares with foals at foot there will be boxes at half height in the tent. But the mares must be tied up in the box. Stallions will be accommodated in their own stables, stud stallions in boxes but with good view of each other and visible for the visitors. Young stallions will probably be accommodated in fenced boxes. The horses will not be accommodated according to nation or owner but according to age or the catalogue number.

## **EXHIBITING OF HORSES IS AT OWN RISK!**

Horses to be exhibited must be accustomed to being tied up as there are no boxes for mares with foals at foot and for mother mares only visitor friendly half height fences. We would like to draw your attention now to the fact that the stables may not be visited, even by the owners, from 21:00 to 06:00 and only the night personnel will ensure calmness in the stable tent, in the interest of the horses there will be no exceptions.

**11. ENTRY FEES:** The entry fee for each horse exhibited is €150,- (Stable fee and hay included). The entry fee must be received by the organizer at the latest by 1. April. The registration is only valid after receipt of the entry fee. In the case of no show or deregistration after 1. April entry fees and insurance contributions will not be refunded.

**12. INSURANCE :** All horses will have an obligatory accident insurance for death or emergency slaughter during the arrival, stay and return of the horses. €60,- ea. stallion, €30,- ea. mare and €15,- ea. foal will be charged at registration. Exact details can be requested for the organizer. Each exhibitor and exhibited horse must have third party liability insurance for the duration of the Haflinger World Show. As the organizer is not liable for any made damages an additional animal insurance for the exhibition horses is recommended.

**13. ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE:** The costs for arrival and departure must be borne by the exhibitor. Arrival is possible starting Tuesday 1. June 2010, but no later than Wednesday, 2. June 2010, 15:00. Without exception departure is possible at the earliest on 6. June at 17:00 after the closing event, only at this time will the certified horse passes be handed out by the official veterinarian and the show office. Departure must take place by the latest on Monday 7. June 2010, 12:00.

**14. VETERINARY REGULATIONS:** Each horse must have proof of vaccination against horse influenza and viral abort e.g. Resequin inoculation, this must be no older than six months and must consist of basic immunization and second vaccination. The certificate of vaccination must be shown upon entry. Desirable is a horse passport (required for horse from the EU). Upon arrival there will be a veterinary medical check. Horses that show signs of illness, even only to a slight extent, will be excluded from the show and will not be allowed to enter the show area. The health of all horses has priority therefore any horse that becomes ill during the show will be asked immediately to leave the show and the show area.

**15. HORSESHOES :** The exhibition horses should as far as possible not be shod, horseshoes on the rear hooves is forbidden in any case. Exceptions can only be granted to horses that take part in the show programme and only with explicit permission in writing of the show management.

**16. CUSTOMS REGULATIONS :** The regulations required to cross the border into Austria will be given to the owners separately.

**17. OTHER REGULATIONS:** We kindly ask the exhibitors to refrain from bringing dogs. In any case dogs must be kept on the leash in the whole show area.

Smoking and taking flash photos is strictly forbidden in the stables. Taking photos, making films or videos is only allowed for personal use. Each exhibitor declares his agreement that he, the person showing the horse and of course the exhibition horse may appear on photos, videos or DVDs. The organizer reserves the right to exercise his property rights. Camping within the show area is explicitly forbidden.
